












Basic Bousky Rose Tutorial By: Michelle Schomburg Material List: Mandrel dipped in bead release, Base Color of your choice, Vine Cane, Clear glass stringers & rod, opaque white stringer, transparent color, Stamen Cane & marvering tool HINTS: Work with small flame! When adding transparent colored dots add them within the edges of previous opaque dot. When adding clear over petals, cover petals completely and melt in slightly to avoid bubbles.		1 	Place small footprint of glass on mandrel.	2 	Marver glass footprint to barrel shape. It will be about .25 to .375" wide.
3 	Add Vine Cane to barrel.	4 	Melt to round.		
5 	Encase vine with clear.	6 	Melt to round.	7 	Add three groups of three opaque white dots for first layer of petals.
8 	Melt to round.	9 	Add dots of transparent color to each petal. Place dot within the opaque white. Melt to Round.	10 	Add clear glass to the top of each group of petals. Melting slightly to avoid bubbles. Melt to round.
11 	Add second group of petals, on top of and in between each of the first set of petals.	12 through 14: Repeat steps 8 thru 10 12 		13 	14 
15 	Add third group of petals, on top of and in between each of the second set of petals.	16 through 18: Repeat steps 8 thru 10 16 		17 	18 
19 	Spot heat and plunge the center of each grouping of petals with stringer or stamen cane.	20 	Melt small amount of clear stringer and carefully fill the hole made by plunging. Melt in slightly.	21 	Add clear glass covering the top of each group of petals. Melt in slightly as you go. This is to avoid bubbles.
22 	Melt to round.	23 	Carefully encase entire bead. Melting very slightly as you go.	24 	Melt to round.
